Elephants call each other by name, study says

Researchers have found that elephants call each other by unique names, just like humans do. This incredible discovery was made in two national parks, Samburu and Amboseli in Kenya. Scientists listened to over 600 elephant calls and learned that each elephant has its own special sound. When elephants heard their sound, they reacted with excitement, showing that they recognised it - just like we recognise our own names!

It took several weeks to build and went over some rough parts of the countryside. When completed, neighbours and friends from the villages gathered and enjoyed a meal together. The aim of Neighbour's Day is to bring communities together, and this huge table certainly did that!



Bird spotted in sky after 600 years

White storks have been extinct in England for over 600 years - since Henry VI was king! Last week, one was spotted flying over the Cheshire countryside. It's all thanks to new efforts to re-introduce them back into the country. This particular stork flew from Cotswold Wildlife Park, where Zookeepers help them to build the skills to survive and thrive in England again. Darren Banks who works for Cheshire Wildlife Trust said: "It was fantastic to witness it circling overhead with its incredible wing span."
